- 2. Do not get the UNNA boot wet.
- 3. Shower or tub bath if you are able to keep boot dry. You may use a plastic bag over the boot.

- Severe itching and rash above or below the UNNA boot
- Coldness, numbness or tingling in the legs
- Change in color or inability to move toes
- · Pain and cramping in the leg
- · Foul-smelling drainage
